Only one entry is allowed per person. Entries can be submitted from now until March 18 at sjpsfoundation@sjschools.org.

The top 30 entries will be posted from March 24 to April 8 at the Dairy Queen along Niles Avenue and Pater True Value on M-139.

Online voting will be conducted at www.stjosephpublicschoolsfoundation.org. The top 10 vote-getting photos will be announced on April 15.

The winner gets the cover photo on the 2016-17 SJPS calendar, a season sports pass, \$25 gift certificate to Silver Beach Pizza and two tickets to Encore 2016. A season sports pass will also be given to the 10 pictures that get the most public votes.

Last year’s winner came from Jacey Kalin, who submitted a photo titled “Thoroughly Modern Millie.”
